    - *Pro D Days Current Work At Staff Meetings:* Action Plan for Learning, Literacy Team, Anti-Racism Book Club, Early Learning, Response to Intervention Team (RIT) addresses the needs of students that may be falling behind.
    - *Respect and Diversity Week Activities:* Daily short videos featuring songs written and recorded by grade 2 & 3 Classes (songs follow the theme of 'Together at Meadows', Daily themed learning activities, Feb. 23- Respect and Diversity T shirt day
    - *Review of the 6 Major Emergency Procedures*
      - **Lockdown** (is used in response to a danger inside the building) Interior doors are locked, Security shutters down, all activity inside the building stops.
      - **Hold and Secure** (Used in response to a danger outside the building) Exterior doors are locked, security shutters are down, normal activity continues inside the building
      - **Evacuation** (used when an Environmental danger inside makes the building unsafe) All Students and Personnel Exits the building, Controlled Release to caregivers.
      - **Shelter In Place** (used when there is an Environmental danger outside the building) Students stay inside the building, controlled release to caregivers
      - **Room Clear** (used for localized hazards or medical emergencies) Students are relocated to another area of the building.
      - **Drop, Cover and Hold** (used during earthquakes) Students take shelter under desks and remain until shaking has stopped for a full 60 seconds. Students then exit the building, controlled release to caregivers.
    - *3rd water bottle filling station is being installed*
